



Parent and Pupil Expectations for Remote Learning using online platforms.

To make our online learning platform areas a supportive and respectful place for parents, children and staff please can you ensure that the following rules are followed:

- Use kind words and images: think carefully about how your words may come across in a non-verbal, chat situation. No offense words, pictures or rude questions, please.
- Be patient: unlike a classroom situation when communication can be given in different ways, there will be one teacher per class with only one way of chatting with one pupil at a time. Teachers will get back to you with ideas, answers and support as soon as they are able.
- Be ready to learn: use your timetable, plan in advance, try your best to be ready for the start of the online lesson. Make sure you have access to some pens, pencils, paper and check you have any printed resources you have been asked to organise.
