



Sadly, due to a changing climate and the harmful effects of human behaviour, many sea creatures across the world are becoming endangered.

The oceans are home to an astonishing amount of life, from the gigantic blue whale (measuring up to 29.9 metres, and weighing up to 173 tonnes), to the miniscule *paedocypris progenetica* fish (measuring a tiny 7.9 millimetres).

Research which animals are in danger and create a poster using statistics to show how their numbers are decreasing. Statistics (representing data as an image) is great for showing your audience the message you want to put across in a quick and precise manner. You could create a pictogram, a bar chart, a line graph or a pie chart. You could draw this, or use excel to help you create your graph.

Make sure it makes your audience see how low some of these numbers are getting and try to use it to get your audience to think about how we can help the numbers increase again.
